

Pony Express

Pony Express was a fast mail service crossing the USA. It began on the Missouri River and reached the Pacific Coast. It was operational from April 1860 to November 1881.

The messages were carried on horseback along prairies, plains, deserts and mountains.

It reduced the time it took the mail to arrive from the Atlantic Ocean to the Pacific Ocean in ten days.

The Pony Express, deployed a year before the start of the American Civil War, reflecting the need for fast and secure communication with the West.

This post ^{existed} there from the XIII century to the XIX century.

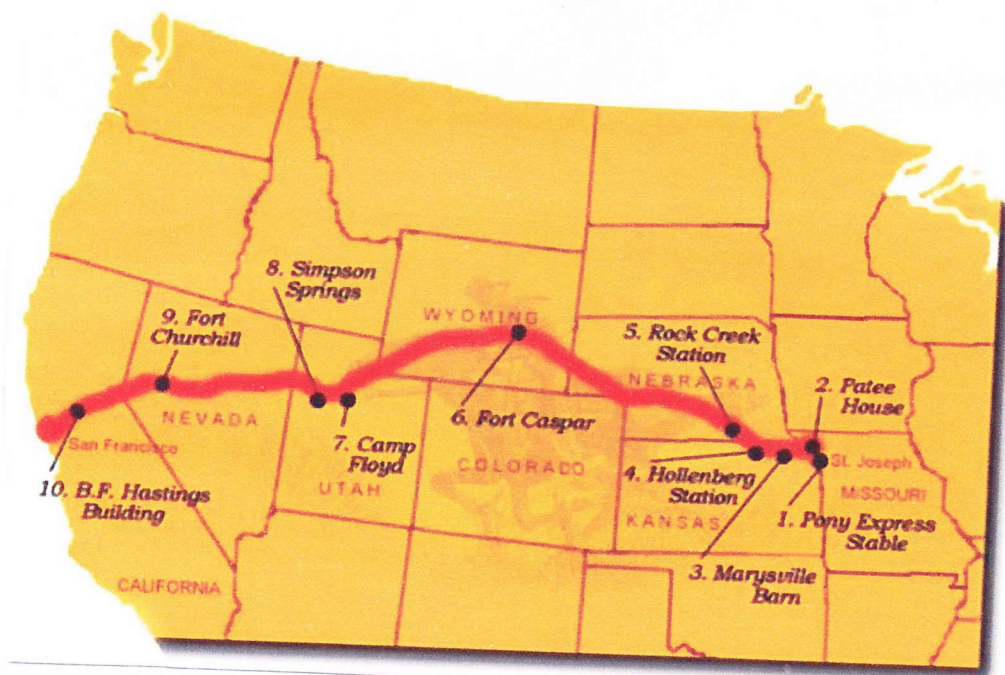
We were used to use pony express especially for fiscal correspondence.

The Pony Express was a fast service to contact the Atlantic Ocean with the Pacific Ocean.

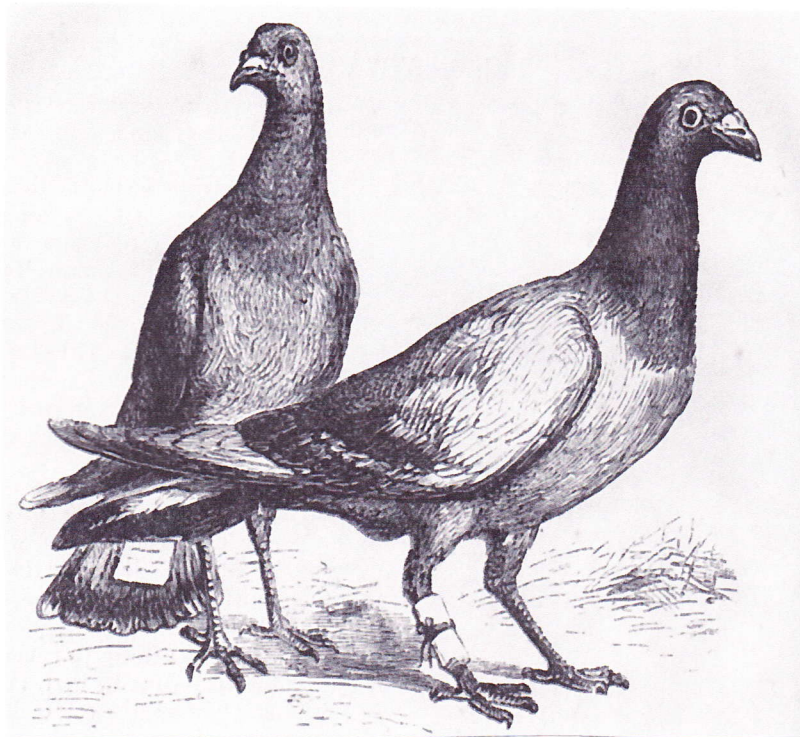


Pigeon post

It was a fast mail service that crossed ^{the USA} the country. It began in Missouri river and arrived to the Pacific coast.

The director of Pony Express wanted ^{to} get the fastest and the safest service.

They also want ^{ed to} get a contract with the government.

Pony Express stations were spaced 16 km along the route, maximum distance that the horses could cross to gallop.

The first rider was James R. Smith, he left from San Francisco.

PIGEON POST

It was an important way in military situations, with 32 pigeons, winner of the 'Dickin medal'.

Egypt was the first civilization that used this mail service.

The pigeons carried two types of messages: official messages and private messages.

Pigeon post was the world's fastest communication system for all the centuries of the Dark and Middle Ages, and remained so until Samuel Morse's invention of the telegraph in 1844 and Guglielmo Marconi's invention of radio in 1895.

At the same time, some places trained falcons to interrupt the service world time.
