

Design a zoo

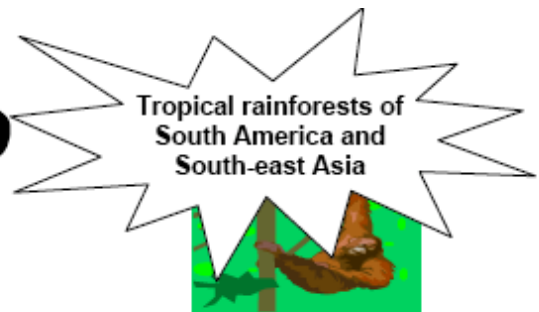
You are going to design a zoo. Here are some things to think about to keep you animals healthy and happy:
